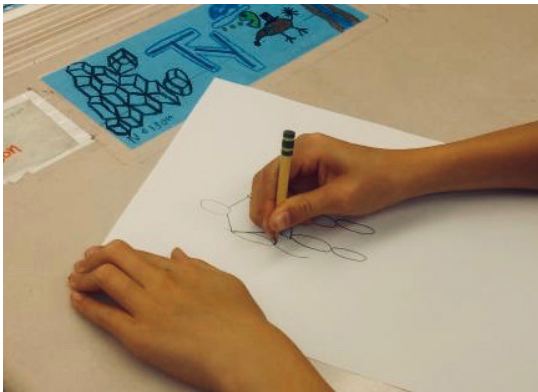


## What is Art Talks?

These interactive programs showcase artwork from the Museum's Permanent Collection and help students engage with art, encourage critical thinking, and experience hands-on art making. Art Talks is a free program available through POPS (Professional Outreach Programs in the Schools).



## Our Programs

### STUDIO: K-6th Grade

- Students learn and practice basic approaches to figure drawing. (30 min.)

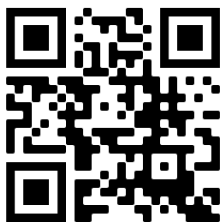
### KID CURATORS: 3-6th Grade
