The PAINT-OUT will be held Saturday, Sep. 7, 2024. Pre-Registration Check-In and Same-Day Registration will be at the Springville Museum of Art, 126 E. 400 S., between 8:00 am - 9:00 am. Painting will start after you are checked in and will conclude that same day at 12:45 pm with a juried, *easel display of your artwork at the Springville Civic Center, 110 S. Main St.

*We will have some easels available, artworks will be displayed on tables if we run out. You are also welcome to bring your own easel.

The Festival will start at 10:00 am, People's Choice Voting will be held while you are painting between 10:00 am - 12:45 pm. Once you submit your completed painting to the exhibition location at Civic Center Park, People's Choice Voting will continue from 1:00 - 2:00 pm and then judges will jury awards between 2:00 - 2:45 pm. The presentation of awards will happen around 3:00 p.m. at the Main Stage Gazebo.

Rules for the juried Plein Air “PAINT OUT” show

1. En Plein Air is defined as a painting of an outdoor scene done entirely on location. We have set a competition area of a ten block square in downtown Springville. (*see attached map*)
2. All paintings entered must be 2 dimensional and completed during the event, all traditional mediums accepted (oils, watercolor, pastel, acrylic, mixed media).
3. Each artist may get up to two canvas, paper, or boards stamped on the back and marked with the artist's name, title, and medium during registration.
4. Only **one entry** will be allowed per person for judging. The “stamp” must be visible to the judges.
5. All surfaces must be free of images prior to stamping. A base coat of paint (any color) is allowed.
6. Artwork must be returned to the Springville Art Festival by 1 pm for judging on

Saturday, Sept. 7th, 2024. The artwork should be displayed on your easel and placed in the appropriate marked area. A map will be provided at check-in.

7. Artist's may sell their work after the judging and will retain 100% of revenue. Artists who sell their work, will be responsible for paying sales taxes to the State of Utah.
8. Each artist must sign a release form and waiver of liability with Springville Public Art for participation in the competition. The participants assume full responsibility for their personal conduct, well-being, and safety during the event.
9. Artists release Springville Public Art the use of photographs of exhibited art works for further publicity and promotional purposes.
10. All artworks must be removed by the buyer or the artist on Saturday, September 7, 2024, by 5:00 pm.

Springville Public Art reserves the right to change or update these rules at any time.
